Nerve – Sural (sensory)	Requires 13 mm or 2 cm length  Dissection of subcutaneous dermal fat between the lateral Malleolus and the Achilles tendon  Manipulate by grasping the fine epineural connective tissue so as to avoid the nerve fascicle proper.  Avoid extra stretching, pinching, bending.	Fresh	Place specimen on a stiff paper or glass slide wrap in a sterile gauze saturated with saline.
